**Purpose:** This is a custom hands-on, course that is designed for female officers who are ready to enhance their defensive tactics skills including officer survival techniques. Areas will cover: Functional fitness, movement and power development, offensive tactics vs. defensive tactics, CQB and fighting to your feet. Survival pistol for day 3 is optional.



### **Requirements:**

**Day 1-2:** Functional clothing, full duty belt-all duty equipment, including flashlight & Taser holster, blue Taser if available, inert OC if available.

**Day 3:** Attendees are required to bring 250 rounds total of standard pistol ammunition, body armor, brimmed hat, wrap-around eye protection, ear protection and full duty gear. \*\*\*A water source and simple carbohydrate is highly recommended.
